

## Abbott BinaxNOW Ag Home Tests Patient Instructions for Use

### Requirements

- Laptop or desktop computer with a webcam, microphone, and speaker; or mobile phone or tablet
- An email address; and
- An internet connection
- Note that at this time, a testing session can be completed end-to-end using a computer with webcam, a cell phone or other mobile device, or a combination of the two.
  - **A testing session should be initiated by going to [ohio.emed.com](http://ohio.emed.com) and selecting “Start Testing.”**
  - A NAVICA account can be created and results can be received and reviewed through the NAVICA app (available in the Apple and Google app stores) or by visiting [www.mynavica.abbott](http://www.mynavica.abbott).



### Process

1. **NOTE: There is nothing the user needs to scan before starting the telehealth session with the proctor.**
2. Create a NAVICA account from the app on your smartphone/tablet or by visiting [www.mynavica.abbott](http://www.mynavica.abbott) and remember your credentials (username and password).
  - If the patient to be tested is a minor, the NAVICA account holder can create Managed Profiles for children and other dependents who might not have a separate email address or are otherwise unable to create a separate NAVICA account.
3. Obtain the test from a designated pickup site (public pickup sites can be [found here](#)), and take the test kit home.
4. Open a web browser on your computer or mobile device, go to [ohio.emed.com](http://ohio.emed.com), and select “Start Testing.”
5. Click the “Login With NAVICA” button on the page and use your NAVICA account credentials.
6. Confirm your account and personal information.
7. Answer the series of questions to prepare for the visit with the eMed proctor and click “Continue.” This will begin the testing session with the eMed proctor.
8. Follow all directions from the eMed proctor to take the test.

## Results

1. After completing the test, the eMed proctor will report results to the Ohio Department of Health.
2. You will receive a “pass” in your NAVICA account (you can access via your NAVICA app or at [www.mynavica.abbott](http://www.mynavica.abbott)).
3. If you test negative, you can show your pass to your school or employer from your smartphone/tablet or print or email your results.

## Helpful Hints

- The telehealth session is required for using the BinaxNOW tests, and can be completed using either a computer with webcam or a mobile device.
- Initiate the testing session by going to [ohio.emed.com](http://ohio.emed.com) and select “Start Testing” to initiate the testing process. There is nothing the user needs to scan before starting the telehealth session with the proctor.
- The eMed proctor is not a healthcare provider but is qualified to administer the test and read the results.
- The BinaxNOW test is authorized for individuals age four and older, but a child under 15 must have an adult perform the swabbing.
- Ensure that you have plenty of space in front of you to use the test kit. The test card must lay flat on a hard surface.
- The eMed proctor will have you adjust your webcam at various times during the testing. The proctor will need to view the test kit on the surface in front of you at certain times and will need to view you (the patient) at other times. For the test to be validated, follow all of the proctor’s instructions. For example, the proctor must be able to view the test card during the 15 minutes the test runs or it will be invalidated.
- You will need to scan the QR code on the test card with your webcam at two separate times during the telehealth session. Make sure you hold the QR code up to the webcam when instructed. Keep the QR code in the center of the camera and hold it as still as possible. There is nothing you need to scan before starting the telehealth session with the proctor.
